From there you will cross the railroad tracks and then turn Right into the Fairgrounds at the south gate, turning left again onto the track and continuing to the STAGE AREA. Just past the Grandstands on the Right Side of the track. After your performance you will then go past the Log Cabin Building and all the way around to the side of the track that is opposite the grandstand where you will then disperse.

NOTE: If you have animals you MUST have a "pooper scooper" accompany you to clean up any mess.
