MISS Noble County Fair Pageant

Information, Rules, and Entry Form

This pageant is recognized across the state as outstanding and innovative. It provides many opportunities for personal growth. The Noble County Pageant is an extensive, educational experience, with the emphasis on helping contestants make the most of themselves. This is accomplished through workshops where contestants will receive assistance with interview skills and networking abilities. They will also be given helpful tips for hairstyles, makeup techniques, and wardrobe for competition. It is also a great way to make lasting friendships with girls from all around the county.

-Single women between the ages of 18-20 years of age as of July 12, 2019 and living in Noble County are eligible for entry. Ladies running for the title of the princess need to be ages 14- 17.

-Each contestant will need to have a sponsor. The sponsor can be a business, club, organization, or even an individual. They will have a sponsor fee of \$100 running for queen. The princess candidates will need to have a \$50 sponsor. Beyond showing their support of the contestant, the sponsor will receive advertisement in the pageant program, social media, and announced during the pageant.

-Entry forms are due no later than Monday, June 3rd.

-Save these dates! -The first workshop will be a Get Acquainted Night held on Monday, June 3. *sponsorship info, and fee due at this meeting.*

-There will be additional workshops and a dress rehearsal before the pageant. Attendance at all workshops and rehearsals is expected. Schedule conflicts must be discussed with the pageant director prior to missing.

-The pageant will be held at the Center Stage Auditorium, Central Noble High School on Friday, July 12th, 2019 at 6:00 p.m.

-Noble County Community Fair Parade will be on Sunday, July 14th, 2019. Attendance by all contestants is highly encouraged.

Miss Noble County Fair Pageant Eligibility

1. Contestants must be at least 18 years of age on/or before July 12, 2019 and cannot have had her 21st birthday as of July 12, 2019.
2. The Queen will be chosen from contestants ages 18-20 in order to follow state fair guidelines.
3. Contestants 14-17 are still encouraged to participate in the pageant and are still eligible to be Miss Noble County Princess.
4. Contestants must not be nor have been married.
5. Contestants cannot have had a child or be knowingly pregnant at the time of the Miss Noble County Fair Queen pageant. If the Fair Queen becomes pregnant during her reign; she will be required to relinquish her title.
6. Contestants must be U.S. citizens and reside in Noble County. One of her parents or legal guardians must also be a resident of Noble County.
7. Contestants must be sponsored by a business, club or individual; that will contribute \$100 to help defray expenses of the pageant.
8. A professional model, one who is paid for modeling, may not be eligible.
9. No previous Miss Noble County Fair Queen is eligible to participate in the pageant a second time.

Miss Noble County Fair Pageant Rules

1. Miss Noble County will be selected at a competitive contest.
2. The county queen contestants will be judged on the basis of poise, personality, and ability to converse. The judging will be divided into four divisions: Interview, Evening Gown, Professional Wear, and Free Choice.
3. Contestants will receive bonus points based on attitude and attendance during workshops and rehearsals. Ten additional points are possible.
4. The selected Miss Noble County Fair Queen will represent Noble County at the Indiana State Fair Queen Pageant and must abide by the Indiana State Fair rules.
5. If the 2019 Fair Queen cannot perform her duties or becomes ineligible before the 2019 Queen is crowned, she will forfeit her title, the crown, and money awarded to the 1st runner up. The line of succession will then continue if the 1st runner-up is unable to fulfill the responsibilities.
6. Prizes will be awarded at the time of the county contest, except the queen's cash reward, which will be presented when the 2020 Miss Noble County Fair Queen is selected.
7. The 2019 Queen and Court will be EXPECTED to be present and assist throughout the fair week of July 14th-July 20th. A modest dress code will be maintained by all for all events. Appropriate behavior will be expected and monitored.
8. All appearances of the Queen in her official capacity throughout the year must be approved by the pageant director.
9. Points and score sheets are for the judge's assessment only and will not be released. Final selection is the judge's decision.
10. The Miss Noble County Fair Queen Pageant is in close accordance with the rules and responsibilities of the Indiana State Fair Queen Pageant.
11. Contestants should give thoughtful consideration to their use of social media and be advised the Noble County Fair Queen Pageant Committee reviews all contestants' internet presence for appropriate online behavior.
12. The Miss Noble County Fair Queen Pageant Committee reserves the right to change the foregoing rules and regulations at any time as may be deemed necessary.
